Sanction Insurance Requirements

Camogie Players who are travelling to the U.S.A. or Canada for the summer **MUST** be registered club members in order to receive a sanction to allow them play on a temporary basis with clubs in these areas. It is mandatory that all players obtain appropriate insurance cover before a permit to the U.S.A. or Canada can be granted. Players can download the CC6 Sanction form to play in North America and Canada at the following link: <http://www.camogie.ie/forms-&-documents.asp>. Sanctions will not be granted **after 1st July**.

The GAA has a scheme in place which provides adequate cover of which the Camogie can avail. Sanctions will **NOT** be processed unless insurance has been purchased. ***(Note persons who take out other insurance such as J1 Visa travel cover providers, need to ensure that cover is provided for injuries sustained whilst playing Camogie. This is not an automatic cover on most travel covers and the persons will need to declare they will be playing Camogie as part of a team and may have to pay an additional premium. They must provide details of their Insurance to The Camogie Association with their sanction before approval can be granted).***

The following are the steps which a player needs to take to purchase the required insurance:

1. Go to the following link - <http://www.acetravellerinsurance.ie/?afl=5781>
2. Choose 'Worldwide' cover 'Up to 6 months'.
3. Members of Clubs in the 32 Counties of Ireland can purchase the insurance; please ignore the reference to the Six Counties, which states 'excluding Northern Ireland'.
4. Choose the **most accurate** number of days that you will be staying in North America/New York/Canada – note clubs cannot play players if their insurance has expired.
5. Please purchase the **'Standard'** cover available as this is the **only** option acceptable for sanctions.
6. Please read and accept the terms and conditions of the policy and apply for the cover.
7. Fill in all the required fields in order to obtain your documentation.
8. Once purchased, the confirmation letter should be submitted along with the Official Sanction Form to your County Secretary who will submit to the Camogie Association.
9. Sanctions will be approved annually.
