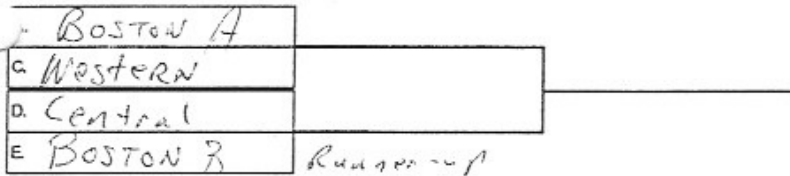

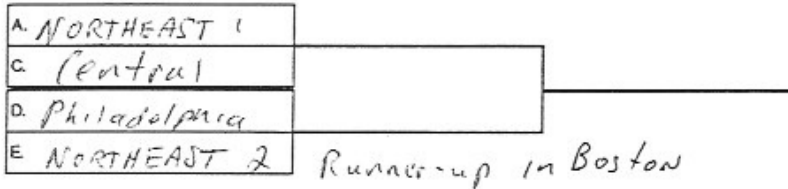
MEN'S SENIOR HURLING

CENTRAL, NORTH EAST, PHILADELPHIA, Western



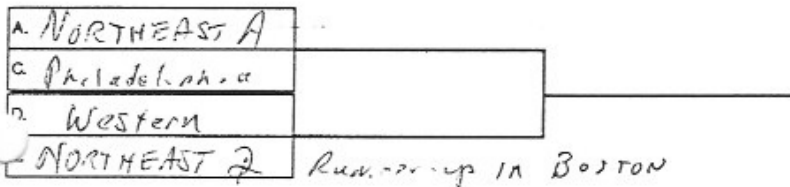
MEN'S SENIOR FOOTBALL

CENTRAL, NORTH EAST, WESTERN, NORTHEAST 2



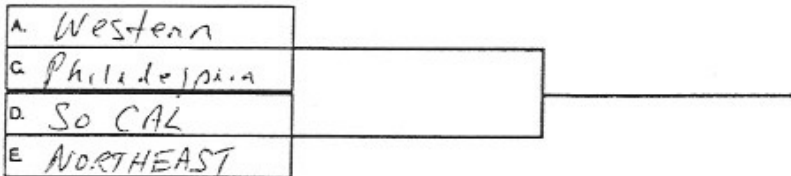

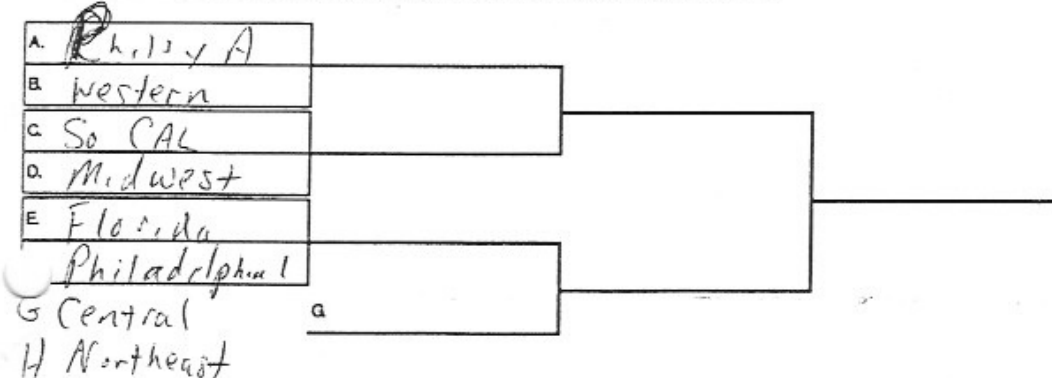

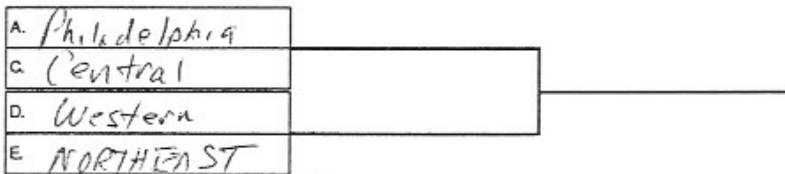

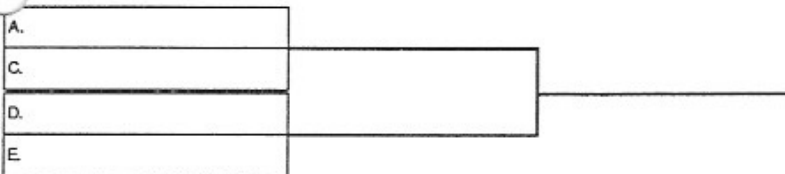
LADIES SENIOR FOOTBALL

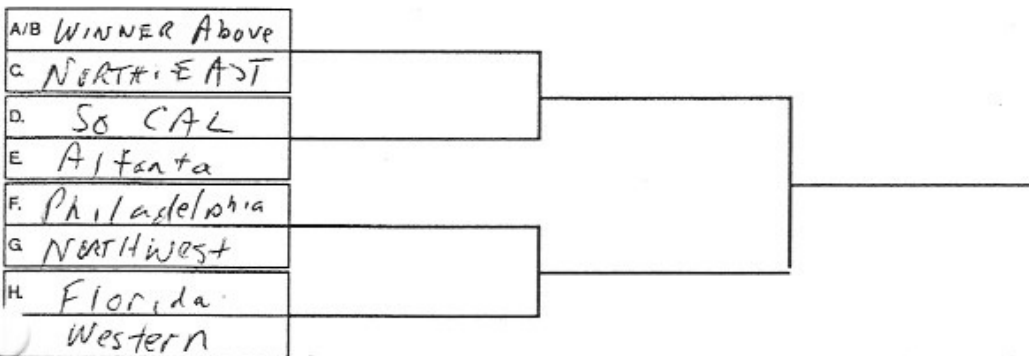

PREIMINARY GAME A. Midwest vs B. Denver



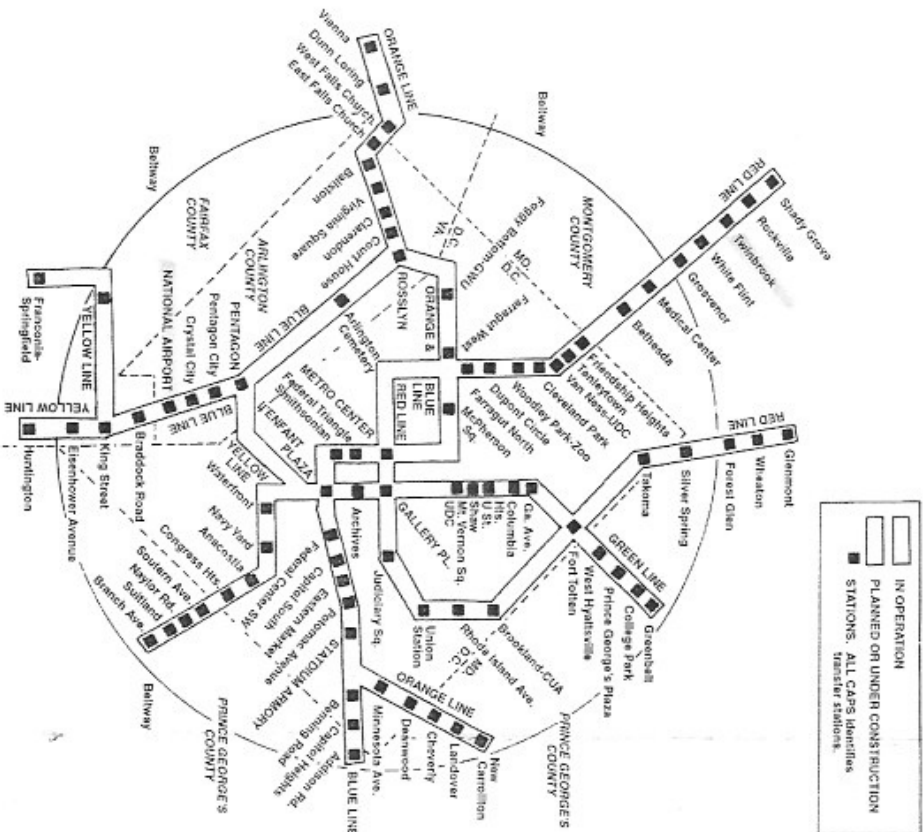
LAYOUT OF WASHINGTON



Washington is divided into four sections: NW, NE, SW, SE. The U.S. Capitol, at the east end of the Mall, is the hub of Washington's streets. The Capitol is situated at the intersection of East Capitol Street, South Capitol Street, North Capitol Street and the Mall, in lieu of a "West Capitol." The three streets and the Mall split the city into these quadrants.

All numbered streets run north and south. Lettered streets run east and west. Streets with state names, such as Rhode Island and Pennsylvania, are diagonals, with the White House as the geographic center of Washington's original 10-mile square.

NACB DIVISION REQUIREMENTS

According to the contract which the NACB has signed with Guinness corporation, the NACB's four major divisions are **EACH** required to do the following:

The Division PRO **MUST** issue regular Press Releases.

The Division **MUST** use the Guinness name in connection with all references to the Championships.

The Division **MUST** prominently reference the names "Guinness", "Harp" and "Kaliber" in all advertising, signage, press releases, media guides, game programs, web sites, public address announcements, television or radio broadcasts, and other promotional material.

The Division **MUST** display field signage, billboards and other advertising material as provided by the Guinness Corporation.

The Division **MUST** have a committee to select a "Guinness Player of the Day" from among all the weekly Sunday adult League games, both Ladies and Men's. Each winner will be presented with a prize (Irish Crystal Trophy) paid for by the NACB.

Each Sunday's winners name and **PHOTOGRAPH**, with the caption "The Guinness Player of the Day", **MUST** be submitted to any local media which covers the games.

At the end of the Championships, one individual from among the weekly winners, will be selected as a "Season MVP". They shall be offered a final prize of a Trip for Two to the All-Ireland Football or Hurling Finals in Dublin, including tickets to the game. If the winner decides not to go to the All-Ireland Final, the final prize shall be \$1,000 cash.
