A Chara,

This is a summary of what has been mailed previously:

1. Team members should arrive at St. Patrick's Training College, Drumcondra, just up the road from Croke Park, on or before Sunday, September 20. Challenge games for both teams are arranged with local Dublin clubs for Sunday evening, September 20, at approx. 6 PM. The players should check-in no later than early afternoon on Sunday. A reception and dinner will follow the challenge games.
2. Rooms are available Free for the players and officials from Sunday, September 20, to check-out on Sunday, September 27, in St. Patrick's Training College. Rooms are also available there both before and after those dates at a cost of IR16 pounds per person for B&B.
3. All matches except the finals will be played at St. Vincent's GAA Club, Malahide Road, Dublin 3. The Finals will be played Friday at the Dublin County Ground, Parnell Park, Donnycarney. Each day, the games start at 4:30 PM with the finals on Friday starting at 2 PM.
4. The men's team plays challenge game on Sunday, 1 game Monday, 2 on Tuesday, 2 on Wednesday, 1 on Thursday, and the final on Friday. The ladies team plays challenge game on Sunday, 1 game Monday, 1 on Tuesday, 1 on Wednesday, 1 on Thursday, and the final on Friday.
5. Buses will transport the teams and officials to events each day. On Monday morning, there will be a tour of the new GAA Museum at Croke Park.
6. Meals will be provided for the teams and officials as follows:
  - ⇒ Sunday: Dinner and Reception
  - ⇒ Monday: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner
  - ⇒ Tuesday-Friday: Breakfast and Dinner
  - ⇒ The Friday evening dinner, on September 25, is a Presentation Banquet at the Burlington Hotel, Dublin.

Detailed schedules will be available at St. Patrick's College in Drumcondra.
