



New Adult Code Development Grant



1. Initial call with USGAA Head of Operations & Games Development to discuss New Adult Code Development Grant
2. Co-ordinate with USGAA Registrar about the registration procedure for the new team within existing club (registrar.usa@gaa.ie)
3. Affiliate with USGAA (<http://usgaa.org/registration/>) registering a minimum of 9 players
4. Identify a suitable coach who commits to attending a USGAA approved Introduction to Coaching Gaelic Games (ICGG) coaching course or, if already completed, attend an Award One course. Assistant coaches are expected, in time, to also complete the ICGG course.
5. Complete the form on the following page and return to rob.tierney.usa@gaa.ie

Note: *New Hurling and Camogie clubs are also eligible to participate in the USGAA Hurling/Camogie grant program whereby clubs receive a grant up to \$800 for purchasing Hurling/Camogie equipment.*
